If the board utilizes simultaneous translation equipment to allow the board to hear the translated public testimony simultaneously, those individuals are allotted 2 minutes each. By law, the Board is allowed to take action only on items on the agenda. The Board may, at its discretion, refer a matter to school staff or calendar the issue for future discussion.

Presentation of Federal Addendum & Application for Funding

The LCAP Federal Addendum is an additional document that complements the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) to ensure compliance with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) provisions. Its purpose is to provide The Cottonwood School with the opportunity to meet the requirements for ESSA funding. A completed template for the LCAP Federal Addendum must be submitted to the California Department of Education (CDE) to apply for ESSA funding.

The LCAP Federal Addendum, alongside the LCAP, is reviewed annually as part of the strategic planning process. During the review process, staff members evaluate the responses the Local Education Agency (LEA) provided to the ESSA plan provisions. It is important to note that California's ESSA State Plan has significantly changed the state's approach to utilizing federal resources in support of underserved student groups.

The LCAP Federal Addendum allows LEAs to document their strategies and approach for maximizing the impact of federal investments in support of underserved students. By completing this addendum, The Cottonwood School can demonstrate its commitment to effectively utilizing federal funds to address the needs of underserved student populations.
